General information about cookies:

A cookie is a small file that asks for permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you have accepted our cookie policy, the file will be placed on your computer, and the cookie will help analyze web traffic or make you aware of it when you visit a certain page. Cookies enable internet applications to respond individually to users. The Internet application can tailor its activities to your needs by collecting and remembering information about your preferences.

Cookies can be divided into two primary types: "Session cookies" and "Persistent cookies". Session cookies only last as long as a user's use of a website lasts, and they are automatically deleted from your computer when you close your browser. Persistent cookies, on the other hand, have a longer lifespan and can be stored on your computer until they are deleted or until they exceed their expiry date.

Currus Connect uses cookies for the following purposes:

1. Improving the website's user-friendliness
2. Administration of the website

Currus Connect uses cookies to help administer our websites, as well as to improve the website's user-friendliness. We place a cookie at the beginning of each visit to this website. The collected data is anonymous and it does NOT track your behavior on the site. When you leave the website, these cookies are automatically deleted.

Cookies do not collect any information that can identify you individually. Likewise, a cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or to information about you.

We secure your information - we are committed to that. To prevent unauthorized access to or disclosure of information, we have integrated appropriate physical, electronic and managerial procedures that can protect and secure the information we collect online.

You can choose to accept or reject cookies. Most Internet browsers automatically accept cookies, but in most cases you can adjust your browser's settings yourself to reject cookies if you prefer. Such action may in some cases prevent you from using certain functions on this website.

Third party cookies

Third-party cookies can be used for the following:

We use Google Analytics (GA) to analyze the use of all our websites. GA generates statistics and other information about website use using cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The generated information relating to our website is used to prepare reports on the use of the website. Google stores and uses the information in question.
